

## Privacy policy in English

We process your personal data in the event that you decide to support us with a sum of money via our website LOKK.dk

LOKK can receive donations in 2 ways: MobilePay a Danish solution that goes over the bank, or with Dankort. In both cases you do grant your consent for us to ask for your surname and surname as well as your email address so we can email to thank you for the reception.

Emails and names are stored in a database at Nianet / GlobalConnect.

We will not send Newsletters to you without a specific request from you. LOKK may create a specific sign-up option on this website, for this later.

**1.** Under **Article 5** of the General Data Protection Regulation GDPR, we must not collect more Personal data than strictly necessary, which we try to comply with.

**2. + 3.** You do have the right to write to us at any time and ask to correct your email address or be deleted in our internal mailing list. According to the Personal Data Regulation's **Article 16** and **Article 17**.

### 1. Article 5 Principles for the processing of personal data

Personal data shall

- be legally, reasonably and transparently processed in relation to the data subject 'Legality, reasonableness and transparency'.
- (b) be collected for explicit and legitimate purposes and may not be processed in a manner incompatible with those purposes; further processing for archival purposes in the public interest, for scientific or historical research purposes or for statistical purposes in accordance with Article 89 (2). Paragraph 1 shall not be considered incompatible with the original purposes ('purpose limitation')
- (c) be sufficient, relevant and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are addressed ('data minimization');

### 2. Article 16 Right to rectification

The data subject has the right to have incorrect personal data corrected by the data controller without undue delay. The data subject has the right to complete incomplete personal data, taking into account the purposes of the processing. by making a supplementary statement

### 3. Article 17

Right to erase ('right to be forgotten')

1. The data subject has the right to have personal data deleted by the data controller without undue delay, and the data controller is obliged to delete personal data without undue delay if any of the following applies:

- Personal data is no longer necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected or otherwise processed.
